In the rapidly evolving health-conscious environment of today, dentistry is a career to be chosen by an increasing number of students who find ample opportunity to pursue promising careers across the world.

The RajaRajeswari Dental College and Hospital was established in 1992, offering a BDS program of study with an intake of 40 students. Today, the college nestled in 5 acre campus is a recognized post-graduate institution offering MDS programs in all disciplines of dentistry, doctoral programs and an intake of 100 students at the BDS level. The college is **affiliated to the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka and is recognized by the Dental Council of India.**

The 2 lakh sq. ft. college and hospital building, houses everything from classrooms and clinics to hostels and libraries. The hospital, with its 9 specialist clinics and 350 electronic dental chairs, caters to 600-800 patients daily. This gives students the opportunity to gain exposure to a wide range of dental problems and the procedures for their resolution.

The Institution boasts about having an active Research & Publication Department which conducts several Research Projects by staff and students. It has been equipped with a **Real Time PCR** which attracts students from various colleges to come and do projects. Anti-Ragging

At most care is taken to ensure the enactment of Anti Ragging Act in the campus. An active Anti Ragging Committee headed by the Principal and Comprising of Senior Teachers, Wardens, Student Representatives and people from local bodies meet regularly to prevent, counsel and take action in case of such activity reported.







Oral Medicine and Radiology

The Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology is the threshold to dentistry for all patients. This Dept. is responsible for the preliminary investigation and diagnosis of dental issues, lesions and systemic diseases through oral manifestations. The Dept. also takes responsibility for the dental management of medically compromised patients.

This Dept. is where students, both at the UG and PG level, gain the ability to examine patients, diagnose issues and practice the clinical skills, vital to good dentistry. The Dept. has a separate radiology section with advanced diagnostic aids such as a cephalostat and

orthopantomograph, T-Scan, digital OPG, RVG and Extra Oral X-ray unit. Patient management is done through a system of computerized records. Students have access to a large number of reference books, educational CDs and online resources through LAN and WiFi. The Dept. has the distinction of being the first in India to be equipped with a **full-fledged T-Scan with biopack at its Orthofacial pain clinic.**

The teaching faculty are excellent academicians with several National and International Publications to their credit.

Future Plans include acquisition of CBCT, making the department a Ph.D center and to start Oral Cancer Research Center.

Prosthetics and Crown & Bridge

The replacement of missing teeth and associated structures due to congenital reasons or due to disease, surgery, aging or accident is the responsibility of the Department of Prosthodontics. Through dental prosthesis, not only are the teeth replaced, but also form and function of surrounding areas such as lips and cheeks are restored.

The Dept. conducts student training in two stages - pre-clinical and clinical Prosthodontics. Teaching is conducted at the UG and PG level and the Dept. is also recognized as a PhD centre. The Dept. is well equipped with the latest Lab equipment such as All Ceramic Furnace, Sterio Microscope, Anatomical Articulators, to replace everything

from a single tooth to the complete set, special procedures include dental Implantology and maxillofacial prosthesis. Several Research Projects are underway including Animal Studies.

The department is closely associated with Oro facial Pain Clinic and study occlusal disharmony and TM Joint disorders with help of the newly acquired **T-Scan and EMG**.

The faculty can boast about their numerous International and National Publications and about the achievement of their PG.'s.

Future plans includes starting of courses in Bite Scan, Long term Research projects in Implants.

Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

The Department of Maxillofacial Surgery is responsible for the surgical treatment of acquired, congenital and traumatic issues related to the jaws and facial regions as well developmental diseases of these areas. Facial fractures, head and neck cancers and salivary gland diseases are the other areas in which the Dept. plays a key role. Major surgeries include those for maxillofacial traumas, cysts and tumours, oral cancer, orthognathic surgery, bone graft, distraction and cleft lip and cleft palate. The Dept. trains students at the UG and PG levels in the surgical procedures conducted and enables them to gain the necessary knowledge and skills.

The department has the advantage of sharing the best of Medical facilities such as **OT, Surgical ICUS 24 hour causality, Inpatient beds and advanced diagnostic aids like MRI, CT with Rajarajeswari Medical College & Hospital** which is a 1100 bedded super speciality teaching institute belonging to the same trust.



Apart from routine tooth extractions and impactions, the department performs surgical procedures for Head and Neck cancers, salivary tumors, cysts, T.M. joint disorders, Orthognathic corrections. All types of trauma, cleft lip and palate corrections.

Attachment and accessibility to super speciality Medical College & Hospital.

Internationally trained Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon and experienced Professors on the faculty.

More than 60 International and 65 National Publications among staff. P.G. Student securing 11th Rank in Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Examination.

The Department has plans to organise National Conferences and to conduct workshop on Microvascular and skull base surgeries. Efforts are being made to make it a PhD center.

Periodontology

The Department of Periodontology is engaged in the treatment of problems associated with the gums and poor dental hygiene. Through a training program comprising both theory and clinical practice, UG and PG students gain knowledge of arrange of treatments and procedures. These include scaling and root planning, splinting and abscess drainage. Surgeries such as flap surgery, micro-gingival surgery and laser assisted surgery are conducted on a regular basis. PG students also undergo training in the latest aesthetic and regenerative procedures using advanced membranes and bone graft

materials. The Dept. is also a recognized centre for Ph.D programs.

The Dept. is equipped with state-of-the-art dental diagnostic and surgical facilities. Modern dental chairs, ultra-sonic scalers, an electrocautery unit and a laser unit enabling superior patient care.

The Dept. also has a range of advanced GTR membranes and bone grafting materials. Critical researches encompass immunology, periodontal plastic surgery, periodontal regeneration, periodontal medicine and dental implants.

Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry

Focussed on good dental hygiene in children, the Department of pedodontics and Preventive dentistry aims to do this through a combination of professionally applied and self applied fluorides, deplaning procedures and placement of occlusal sealants. The objective is to prevent dental caries, gingivitis and periodontal diseases. The Dept. also treats habitual problems and developing malocclusions. UG and PG students are exposed to the dental issues faced by children and adolescents and get an opportunity to educate them provide preventive treatment.

The Dept. is equipped with 37 special child friendly dental chairs as

well as a conscious sedation unit. The Dept. has a unique children's recreation area that contains special toys and oral education room which enables children to learn better dental hygiene and practice it in their daily lives. The Dept. also regularly conducts camps and clinics in schools and rural areas.

Future Plans includes department collaboration with pediatric specialty to manage children with special health care needs, International collaboration and exchange. Programmes for students and staff, Digitalized department library and faculty student exchange programme at national & International level.







Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics

One of the busiest Departments of the college, the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics aims at 'increasing the lifespan of teeth'. Towards this end, the department offers root canal treatment and endodontic surgeries and metallic and non metallic restorations. UG and PG students gain thorough knowledge of areas such as endodontic treatment, endodontic microsurgery, regenerative endodontics and management of traumatic injuries. The Dept. also teaches students, the procedures involved in aesthetic dentistry.

The Dept. is fully equipped with facilities such as Vista Scan, thermo-plasticized gutta-percha system, rotary endodontic system, power bleaching, LED light curing unit, endosonics and a complete ceramics

lab. These enable students to, watch, understand and gain hands-on experience on the complete range of treatments and procedures.

A new department namely, Aesthetic Dentistry has been created to deal with the present needs of patients who want beautification of smiles.

Faculty has authored a Text book on Endodontics. Several National and International Publications have been published by the staff.

Future plans include conducting workshops on Endo Microsurgical procedures and to make the department as a Ph.D center.

Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics

The Department of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics specializes in the correction of defects in the jaws and teeth through the use of various removable and fixed appliances. Treatment takes the form of pre-adjusted edgewise appliances, **lingual appliances**, ceramic braces, myofunctional appliances, clear aligners, surgical orthodontics and micro implant based orthodontics.

The Department has excellent facilities ranging from separate UG and PG clinics with computers connected to a central server. The Department has an advanced digital imaging and treatment simulation system, a first, which enables planning of complex procedures.

The Department is a center of excellence **recognized for PhD course by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences**. A combination of classroom lectures and practical experience at the clinic provides students with excellent understanding of procedures. With research being an important goal of the Dept. all PG and PhD students

undertake research projects. The Dept. currently has around a 1000 on-going cases covering all aspects of the speciality.

It is the first orthodontic department in our state to acquire Dolphin Imaging Software for diagnosis. By creating individual computer terminals for P.G.'s the department works, without paper on diagnosis and treatment of patients.

Apart from numerous National and International Publications the staff has 9 patents out of which 4 has been applied for Registration.

Royal college of Physicians and surgeons of Glasgow, UK, has awarded FDS RCPS (Glasg) to Prof. Emeritus Dr. Edwin Devadoss and MFDS for HOD Prof. Dr. Rajkumar Alle, recognizing their contribution to Orthodontics.

Future plans are to make it a center for M.Ortho (Glasgow) examination and to conduct regular courses on lingual orthodontics.

Public Health Dentistry

The Department of Public Health Dentistry is oriented towards meeting the oral health needs of communities that lack dental health facilities. The objective is to bring people at large within the fold of dental health through outreach programs. Through Rural dental camps and adopted satellite centres, the Dept. communicates the basics of good oral care using charts, audio-visual aids and educational sessions. The Dept. also renders dental care and referrals to specialist clinics as and when needed.

The UG and PG students of the college gain first-hand experience of dentistry at the grass-roots level and a sense of social commitment through interaction with the less privileged members of the society.

The Department operates a **Modern well equipped Mobile Dental Clinic** that travels to even remote locations and serves rural communities.

The 4 satellite centres functions with permanent staff and provide comprehensive dental care to the surrounding populations.

Achievements includes securing **University ranks by our P.G.'s and the best P.G. award won by Dr. Amith Kumar in 2013 at National level.**

Several National and International Publications have been authored by the staff.

Future plans include collaboration with other International NGOs. Organizing P.G. Conventions and National Conferences.

Oral Pathology and Microbiology

The Department of Oral Pathology and Microbiology, focuses on the nature, identification and management of diseases affecting the oral and maxillofacial regions as well as associated structures. This speciality is a confluence of basic sciences and clinical dentistry where UG and PG students learn the conduct of routine blood and urine analysis and histopathological examinations. The Dept. is also actively conducting research in HIV-AIDS, laser induced wound healing, karyotyping, molecular studies and Oral cancer using advanced immuno-histochemical methods, besides the micro-biological aspects of oral infections.

The modern histopathological and microbiological lab is equipped with semi automatic microtome, tissue processor, Research and

Penta head Microscopes labs for UG and PG students. A pathology museum with a collection of over 2000 histopathology slides and rare specimens supplements the vast array of specialized texts and journals available with the Dept.

Over 60 National and International Publications have been done by the staff. Many papers were presented at International conferences by them.

Future plans include making this as a Ph.D center, inviting National conferences and make the department as a Diagnostic Center for nearby practicing dentists.

Classrooms, Library, Indoor Auditorium

The classrooms at RajaRajeswari Dental College are spacious and well designed with an emphasis on enabling teacher-student interaction. Modern teaching aids and minor operation theatres with projection systems give students the opportunity to observe closely and understand the conduct of dental surgical procedures.

The college library has a air-conditioned facility with over 6000 volumes related to the subject matter of dentistry. The library also

subscribes to over 90 national and international journals to help students keep abreast of advances in the field. Through Helinet, students can access arrange of e-journals. Additionally, students have open access to the vast library (over 45000 sq. ft. area) at RajaRajeswari Medical College.

The college has a large indoor auditorium with excellent acoustics that is used for the regular seminars and workshops, forming part of the learning process at the college.





Workshops & Conferences

RajaRajeswari Dental College & Hospital spares no effort in bringing the latest development in the dental speciality to the institution through their CDE programmes / Conferences / Workshops / Hands on courses. While every department conducts Monthly clinical meets, renowned invited speakers from India and abroad bring expertise to the audience through these meetings.

Orthognathic Surgical Workshop

Surgical Correction of Jaw deformities leading to malocclusion and facial disfigurement is the ultimate treatment. Very few centers practice this delicate surgeries. In Order to train young Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons in this specialized field, RajaRajeswari Dental College & Hospital in collaboration with Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow (U.K.) and FACE organized a two days workshop including live surgical demonstration by world renowned surgeons from U.K. and expert from India. Dr. David Koppel and Dr. Alastair Gardner from Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow, U.K. participated in this workshop and demonstrated surgical procedures on patients which was delivered live from O.T.

Hands on Workshop on Bone Grafting in Implants

A one day workshop and Hands on Course on Implant was conducted by Implantology department on 15th May 2010. World renowned Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon and Implantologist Prof. Nadir Khan from Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburg, U.K. discussed the latest developments in

Implantology including CBCT, Scans, Sinus lifts and Bone grafting techniques. Lectures were followed by Surgical demonstrations of bone grafting and interactive sessions. The delegates were very appreciative of this exposure.

Pre Conference Hands on Workshop of 19th Indian Society of Oral Implantology Conference

Pre-Conference, Hands on Workshop of 19th Indian Society of Oral Implantology Conference of 2012 was conducted at Rajarajeswari Dental College & Hospital on 26th October 2012. Prof. Raj Patel Shah, a well known Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon and Implantologist from U.K. conducted Hands on Workshop on Soft Tissue Management around Implants, Soft tissue harvesting and grafting. Hands on course was conducted on goat jaws. 20 participants from all over India enrolled for this unique course conducted by an expert from U.K.

CDE Programme

CDE programme on "Infection control in Dentistry" was conducted on 21st March 2014 by the department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, RajaRajeswari Dental College & Hospital with attendance of 150 members. Topics like cross contaminations, needle stick injury, fumigation and how to maintain hygiene in dental clinic were discussed. Proper surgical waste disposal, Treating highly infective patients suffering from HIV, Hepatitis and other diseases were demonstrated. The programme was educative and very useful to all clinicians.





Hostels, Outdoor Auditorium, Transport

The RajaRajeswari Dental College campus incorporates comfortable accommodation for out-station students in the form of separate Girls and Boys hostels.
